

## Frequently Asked Questions

---

**Q: Where will THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson take place?**

A: The tournament will be held at TPC Craig Ranch on May 18 - May 24, 2026

**Q: Who is the title sponsor for THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson?**

A: The CJ Group is the title sponsor of the 2026 tournament.

**Q: How many PGA TOUR professionals are in the field?**

A: 157 professionals are anticipated to compete with a cut after Friday to approximately 75 professionals.

**Q: What are the benefits of volunteering?**

A: Volunteer perks for THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson volunteers:

- Official tournament uniform
- Complimentary meals on the days that you work as a volunteer
- Complimentary volunteer parking
- Volunteer credential good for entrance to tournament on non-volunteer days

**Q: Will there be a new volunteer uniform for 2026?**

A: No, THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson polos will remain the same from 2025. If you are a new volunteer in 2026, you will need to purchase THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson polo. The bottoms will remain the same Navy-blue pants.


Additional uniform apparel will be for sale during THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson (sizes limited).

**Q: Why do I need to pay to volunteer?**

A: THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson is organized and managed by the Salesmanship Club of Dallas, a non-profit organization that works under PGA TOUR policies. As a part of the PGA TOUR, our volunteers are required to wear a specific uniform, including a tournament-issued golf polo, outerwear, and headwear. Momentous Institute is the beneficiary of the golf tournament. We work very hard to keep this cost as low as possible each year while making it an exceptional experience for all involved.

**Q: What do I wear with my uniform?**

A: A white THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson logo shirt is required for all. Men can wear any golf course appropriate navy-blue pants or shorts. Ladies can wear any golf course appropriate navy-blue capris, pants, or mid-thigh length shorts or skirts. Please, no denim or cargo shorts.



**Q: When and where is uniform distribution?**

A: Days and Times:

- Saturday, May 16 – 11 am- 3 pm Location: TPC Craig Ranch, Volunteer Tent, 6234 TPC Dr., McKinney, TX 75070

**Q: If I can't pick up my uniform on May 16 where can I get it?**

A: You may send a representative in your place to pick up your uniform. Representatives can select one day to pick up both their uniform package and your uniform package. Or you may pick up your uniform package Sunday, May 17 - Wednesday, May 20 at the Volunteer Tent between the hours of 9am-6pm.

**Q: When and where can I purchase additional volunteer merchandise?**

A: Extra volunteer merchandise will be on sale in the volunteer tent during tournament week.

**Q: Can I be on the same committee in 2026 as I've been on in the past?**

A: Committees are filled on a first come, first serve basis but we always try to give volunteers their first preference when available.

**Q: I don't see the committee I usually volunteer for on the committee list, where is it?**

A: Carefully review the volunteer committee descriptions, the PGA TOUR is making a concentrated effort to streamline the volunteer committee structure across all PGA TOUR tournaments and has reinvented a handful of committee titles. If you still do not see the committee you desire, it may be full, and you can sign up for the waitlist.

**Q: When will I receive my committee assignment?**

A: You can expect to receive your committee assignment within one month of tournament week.

**Q: When will I receive my volunteer credential?**

A: All volunteer credentials will be given to the committee chairs for distribution. The committee chair will inform you when credentials will be distributed. Could be when you report for your first shift, at training, or orientation day.


**Q: Does my committee require training?**

A: Not all volunteers will be required to attend a training. Committee chairs will notify you if there is training and when. Most competition support committees including Walking Scorers and Shotlink 2 Mobil Spotter (SMS) have mandatory training sessions. The specific dates and locations for all committees that require training will be announced later.

**Q: Where is volunteer parking?**

A: Volunteer parking will be located at Collin College Frisco, 10500 Ohio Dr., Frisco, TX 75035. Parking shuttles begin on Thursday, May 21 – Sunday, May 24. Designated volunteer shuttles start at 5am from Collin College Frisco.

Volunteers may also park at McKinney ISD Stadium, 4201 S Hardin Blvd, McKinney, TX 75070. This is the general parking lot and will not have a designated volunteer parking area or designated volunteer shuttle.



Parking Saturday, May 16 - Wednesday, May 20 will be in designated lots around the volunteer tent and tournament entrance. There should be some street parking as well. Follow signs for Lot 5.

**Q: Do we have to pay for parking?**

A: No, Volunteer parking is complimentary with a valid 2026 volunteer credential.

**Q: Will I be able to watch the tournament while I am not volunteering?**

A: Yes, volunteers will be able to watch the tournament before or after their shift. Volunteers will also have complimentary access to the tournament with their credential on days they do not have a shift.

**Q: Are meals provided while volunteering?**

A: Yes, breakfast is available in the Volunteer Tent starting at 6am Wednesday – Sunday. Breakfast is over when we run out of food or by 10am. Lunch will be either delivered to you on the golf course or available in the Volunteer Tent. To receive lunch, you must be volunteering during the lunch time, 11am to 1pm. Water and sodas are also available in the Volunteer Tent. Please take drinks with you to our volunteer location. You may also bring a water bottle. There will be water stations on the golf course.

**Q: Can I drink alcohol while volunteering?**

A: No, please do not drink alcohol during your shift(s). When you are finished volunteering for the day, you may come to the Volunteer Tent for a refreshing beverage and snacks. Note- Alcohol will not be served until 3pm each day in the Volunteer Tent.

**Q: Can I bring a bag into the tournament?**

A: Yes, all volunteers must adhere to the tournament bag policy. Bags smaller than 6'x6'x6' and clear bags smaller than 12'x6'x12' are permitted. All volunteers and bags will be screened before being allowed on tournament grounds.

**Q: Can I bring my child or guest with me while volunteering?**

A: Yes, children up to age 15 receive complimentary admission to the tournament. All guests over the age of 15 are required to have a ticket. Please do not bring children that require you to watch them while volunteering. Children should be at an appropriate age to be unattended. We need volunteers to be focused on their duty and not their children.

**Q: I sent in an application to be a volunteer, but now I can't work due to an emergency, etc.**

A: If already scheduled, please contact your committee chair. If before assigned to a committee or shift, email [volunteer@salesmanshipclub.org](mailto:volunteer@salesmanshipclub.org) to let us know you if you are unable to volunteer.

**Q: Does my volunteer credential give me access to shared or private hospitality?**

A: Shared and private hospitality areas are reserved exclusively for ticket holders of those venues. Volunteers may only enter these spaces when required to fulfill specific, assigned volunteer responsibilities and should not access them for personal use.
